

# **Kutztown University Policy ACA-071**

### **Dual Degrees/Simultaneous Degrees – Undergraduate Students**

## A. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to outline procedures for simultaneously completing two or more degrees or majors at Kutztown University.

## B. Scope

This policy applies to all undergraduate students at Kutztown University.

### C. Keywords and Phrases

Dual/simultaneous major: pursuing more than one undergraduate major concurrently with a first major of the same degree, such as a B.A. in English and a B.A. in History.

Dual/simultaneous degree: pursuing more than one undergraduate major concurrently with a first major in a different degree area, such as a B.S. in Computer Science and a B.A. in History.

Second degree: pursuing a second undergraduate degree after completing a first degree. See Policy ACA-073 Second Degree – Undergraduate Students.

#### **D.** Policy and Procedure(s)

Students at Kutztown University may apply to pursue more than one undergraduate major/degree concurrently with the first. Two diplomas will be awarded to students completing dual degrees. A single diploma will be awarded to students completing dual majors. Students must be admitted to each major/degree and must fulfill all of the requirements listed below.

To earn a dual/simultaneous major/degree:

- 1. The student may not be graduated until both majors/degrees are completed.
- 2. All requirements for the curriculum of each major/degree must be satisfied.
- 3. A course required in both degree programs does not have to be repeated for the second degree.
- 4. A student must earn at least 18 credits in each major/degree that are not required in the other major/degree.
- 5. All University requirements such as minimum GPA and number of credits taken at Kutztown University in the major must be met for each degree separately.
