## Anthropology Minor Requirements

The anthropology minor provides students an overview of human behavior from a comparative and holistic perspective, and how to apply this knowledge to understand contemporary issues in our own and other cultures. Minors may take courses focused on each of anthropology's four fields: social-cultural anthropology, linguistic anthropology, archeology and biological anthropology. The minor helps to prepare students for careers in a variety of professions concerned with contemporary social and cultural processes, including careers in social services, international affairs, cultural events, museums, cultural resources management, public service and private business.

Program requirements: 18 credits. At least 9 semester hours must be taken at the 200-level or above. A course cannot count as an elective if used as a required course. The final GPA requirement for the Anthropology minor is 2.0. The Anthropology minor is not available to Anthropology major students.
