Art History Minor Requirements

The Art History minor enhances degrees awarded for the Bachelor of Fine Arts in various visual arts programs, the Bachelor of Science in Art Education and it complements bachelor's degrees in related disciplines in humanities and social sciences, such as literature, history, anthropology, psychology and others. Students explore social and cultural history through the lens of visual arts, reaching from the prehistoric to the global contemporary.

Student Learning Objectives

- 1. Critically evaluate cultural artifacts according to the principles of Formal Analysis.
- 2. Employ the language of Art History to communicate effectively.
- 3. Apply diverse critical methodologies to the analysis of cultural artifacts.
- 4. Execute a professional-quality art historical research project.

Note that all students much achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. Art History program requirements: 18 credits. The final GPA requirement for Program Name is 2.0. Art History minor may not be taken by Art History majors.
