# KU Audio Engineering Minor Program Requirements

The Audio Engineering Minor serves the needs of musicians and non-musicians alike who wish to learn more about the vast area of the commercial music industry. The field of audio engineering has the unique capacity to engage students with a concrete knowledge base of technical proficiency for recording, editing and mastering musical performances while using critical assessment skills to evaluate usage decisions with current hardware and software.

Note that all students much achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. Program requirement: 18 credits.
