# B.A. Art History Requirements

The Art History major prepares students for careers in museums, galleries, historic sites, arts organizations, and various academic pursuits. Students explore social and cultural history through the lens of the visual arts, reaching from the prehistoric to the global contemporary.

### Student Learning Objectives

- 1. Critically evaluate cultural artifacts according to the principles of formal analysis.
- 2. Employ the language of Art History to communicate effectively.
- 3. Apply diverse critical methodologies to the analysis of cultural artifacts.
- 4. Execute a professional-quality art historical research project.

Note that all students must achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. The final GPA requirement for Art History is 2.0.

### Additional Notes:

Kutztown University requires 120 total credit hours for graduation. The General Education program consists of 42 credits, while the B.A. in Art History requires an additional 42 credits with 36 credits remaining for free electives, minors, or a second major.

Many subjects related to Art History can be studied at Kutztown University as part of minor programs or double majors. Such complementary subjects include Anthropology, Digital Communication & New Media, History, Literature, Library Science, Music History, Pennsylvania German Studies, Philosophy, Political Science, Professional Writing, Sociology, Studio Art, Women's Gender & Sexuality Studies, and many others.

Most graduate programs in Art History require a foreign language; Modern Language electives are suggested for students interested in further study.

Studio art courses without prerequisites include ART 061 (Ceramics I for Non-Majors), ART 041 (Weaving for Non-Majors), ART 042 (Textiles and Materials Studies for Non-Majors), FAR 14 (Elements of Drawing for Non-Art Majors); FAR 61 (Introduction to Darkroom Photography for Non-Art Majors); FAR 62 (Digital Photography for Non-Art Majors).
