

The History major focuses on the study of past human experiences. The major broadens students' knowledge of historic content and develops their researching, writing, and critical thinking skills. This major provides a foundation for post-secondary study and for careers related to history such as archive management, government, museum studies, and historical preservation.

Note that all students must achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. The final GPA requirement for History is 2.0. Students must successfully pass a comprehensive examination.
