B.A. Commercial Music Requirements

A track in Commercial Music Studies will prepare students who wish to pursue careers in recording studios, arts administration, performance of popular music, and other positions in the music industry. The program is comprised of a combination of mentoring from renowned artists/teachers, small class sizes, diverse commercial performance opportunities, and a well-rounded academic curriculum

- 2. Identify, define, and engage the elements of music in sound and notation.
- 3. Describe current practices and historical trends in music.
