KU BSBA Accounting Requirements

The accounting program at Kutztown University provides students with a knowledge base in both financial and managerial accounting. The accounting courses expose students to a broad array of accounting skills which are necessary for management responsibility within a company, in the field of public accounting, or for pursuing a graduate program. The program provides customizable coursework through three discipline tracks (Business Analysis & Reporting, Information System and Controls, or Tax Compliance & Planning), which prepare students for the Certified Public Accounting (CPA) exam.

Please be aware that Pennsylvania and most states require individuals to complete a minimum of 150 hours of college credits to qualify for CPA licensure.

Student Learning Objectives

Upon completion of the accounting program, students will be able to:

- 1. Prepare financial statements which are useful to external decision-making.
- 2. Solve business problems analytically to make well-informed decisions.
- 3. Demonstrate research skills and use technological tools to solve accounting problems.
- 4. Recognize ethical issues and their implication in professional judgement.

Note that all students must achieve a minimum of 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. The final GPA requirement for BSBA/Accounting and business core courses, separately, are also 2.0.


