

The general business program provides students with a broad understanding of various aspects of business, including management, marketing, finance, accounting, supply chain management, economics, human resource management and personal financial planning. It covers a variety of foundational principles and skills necessary for success in diverse business environments.

#### Student Learning Objectives

Upon completion of the general business program, students will be able to:

- 1. Communication
  - a. Oral Communication: communicate effectively by speaking clearly, concisely, and convincingly, using appropriate business conventions for the field of study.
  - b. Written Communication: communicate effectively by writing clearly, concisely, and convincingly, using appropriate business conventions for the field of study.
  - c. Interpersonal Skills: demonstrate effective interpersonal skills, especially working in teams.
- 2. Critical Thinking
  - a. Data Analysis: analyze data by using appropriate technology.
  - b. Decision Making: analyze issues critically and make relevant decisions by identifying and assessing the significance of key factors and assumptions.
  - c. Functional Knowledge: identify, define, and apply current fundamental concepts, principles, and practices in the disciplines of business, including globalization.
- 3. Societal Impact
  - a. Ethical Judgment: identify ethical breaches and how they adversely impact stakeholders.
  - b. Social Responsibility: evaluate how business decisions impact the welfare of society.

Note that all students must achieve a minimum of 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. The final GPA requirement for BSBA/General Business and business core courses, separately, are also 2.0.
