The Social Work major offers opportunities for careers that offer deep personal meaning, action, diversity of field, satisfaction, and an abundance of options. With a Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) you'll be prepared to apply your passion for helping others in a fulfilling career promoting social justice, community, family, and personal well-being. You will take a 400-hour senior level internship in fields such as mental health, addictions, community development, advocacy, schools, hospitals, public and private child welfare agencies. At any time during the four-year program, you may develop a plan to complete both the BSW and the Master of Social Work (MSW) in as little as five years.

Note that all students must achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. The final GPA requirement for Social Work is 2.0. A "C" or better is required in all social work courses.
