# B.S. General Studies: Professional Studies Requirements

General Studies: Professional Studies is an interdisciplinary program designed to maximize flexibility for students returning to higher education to finish their bachelor's degree. By combining existing and new coursework, students can choose to concentrate their major program in a single discipline or combine courses from two different disciplines into a single program of study.

#### Student Learning Objectives

- 1. Critically analyze complex issues and evaluate diverse perspectives.
- 2. Integrate knowledge from multiple disciplines to answer questions and solve problems.
- 3. Demonstrate effective written and oral communication skills across different contexts and audiences.

Note that all students much achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. The final GPA requirement for General Studies is 2.0. Students admitted to this program must not have been enrolled in an institution of higher education within the past three years. Additionally, students admitted to this program must have already completed at least 90 credits of university coursework.

## Option A: Concentration Courses – 30 credits (single discipline)

Concentration courses must be in a single discipline. At least 12 of the credits must be 200-level or higher.

# Option B: Concentration Courses – 36 credits (two disciplines)

Students complete 18 credits in two different disciplines. At least 12 of the credits must be 200-level or higher.
