B.S. General Studies Requirements

General Studies is an interdisciplinary program designed to optimize student creativity and flexibility. Instead of focusing intensely on one area in a pre-defined curriculum, students can custom tailor their plan of study to their individual interests and career goals. By combining coursework from multiple disciplines, the BS in General Studies is ideal for students seeking a well-rounded education that fosters critical thinking and problem-solving skills as well as knowledge and foci in one or more disciplines.

Student Learning Objectives

- 1. Critically analyze complex issues and evaluate diverse perspectives.
- 2. Integrate knowledge from multiple disciplines to answer questions and solve problems.
- 3. Demonstrate effective written and oral communication skills across different contexts and audiences.

Note that all students much achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. The final GPA requirement for General Studies is 2.0.

Required BS General Studies Concentration Courses – 21 credits

Concentration courses must be in a single discipline. At least 12 of the 21 credits must be 200-level or above. At least 3 credits must be a culminating experience consisting of an internship, independent study, or senior seminar in lieu of a comprehensive exam.

Concentration courses (9 credits)

Program Courses – 30 to 39 credits

Program courses may be from multiple disciplines including the concentration discipline. Program courses are defined by the prospectus, which is developed by the student and General Studies advisor. The prospectus must be approved by the General Studies committee prior to acceptance into the General Studies program.
