

KU Cinematography Certificate Requirements

The Cinematography Certificate includes classes in cinematography, cinema lighting and advanced cinematography. Classes in this certificate support camera methods, industry standard equipment, production design, and lighting techniques resulting professional-looking productions, from business commercials to short films. This certificate introduces students to the step-by-step process of cinematography that will be useful in a broad scope of industries and workplaces.

Program Requirements: 9 credits. Students must earn a “C” or higher in all required courses.
