



Television Production Certificate Requirements

The Television Production certificate brings the live aspect into video production, with classes in studio production, digital media graphics and live event production. Students participate in television studio and control room environments creating real-world, hands-on productions of live sports events, music performances and ceremonies. They also learn to design and place broadcast graphics.

Program Requirements: 12 credits. Students must earn a “C” or higher in all required courses.
