Professional Studies in Music Certificate Requirements

The Professional Studies in Music certificate program was created to address the needs of students who have an undergraduate degree in music but would benefit from an additional year of study before pursuing a Master's degree or embarking on their musical career. Comprising 12 credits taken over two semesters, the program would offer students from the US and abroad the opportunity to refine their focus and develop their skills to the fullest extent.

Courses would include private lessons, chamber music and conducting, as well as electives in music history, audio engineering, and music education, or other subjects that might not have been covered during an undergraduate program of study.

Note that all students much achieve 12 credits.
