Program requirements: 18 credits. The final GPA requirement for the Cybersecurity certificate is 2.0. The Cybersecurity certificate also requires at least half of the coursework to be completed at Kutztown University. No student may use more than three courses from their major towards the Cybersecurity certificate.
