



## Criminal Justice Minor Requirements

The minor in criminal justice provides students with an understanding of the origin, aims, operation, and impact of the criminal justice system. Students from a variety of majors choose to minor in criminal justice. The minor requires successful completion of Introduction to Criminal Justice, in addition to five other criminal justice courses. Half of the courses in the minor must be at the 200-level or above, and at least half of the eighteen credits must be taken at Kutztown University.

### **Required Criminal Justice Core Course – 3 credits**

CRJU 010 Introduction to Criminal Justice (3 credits)

### **Elective courses – 15 credits**

*Select five additional courses with CRJU prefix other than CRJU 010.*

#### **Note:**

*In order to receive transcript recognition of a minor program, students must complete half of the minor course work at KU AND must earn a minimum G.P.A. of 2.00 in their minor course work. A grade of “C” or higher is required for CRJU 010 Intro to Criminal Justice. At least nine S.H. must be taken at the 200 level or above. CRJU 880s will count as 100-level courses.*
