

Cinema, Media, and Television Production Minor Program Requirements

Students majoring in other programs have the opportunity to learn a variety of skills in the Cinema, Television and Media Production minor, gaining knowledge in the production and theory of cinema, television, and media. As many fields require more media production skills expanding into online territories, a minor in Cinema, Television, and Media Production will give students the upper hand with a modern set of valuable skills.
