ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

- ❑ A clear TB test result and criminal background reports as required by Act 34 Criminal History Report, Act 114 FBI Federal Criminal History, Act 151 Child Abuse History, and Act 24 Arrest/Conviction Report.
- ❑ All clearances need to be on file prior to your starting the program. Clearances take approximately 4 – 6 weeks to process.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR REGULAR ADMISSION:

- ❑ 3.0 Average in a BA or a BFA degree in the Visual Arts or related field.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

REQUIREMENTS FOR ART EDUCATION FIELD EXPERIENCE (ARU 475):

- ❑ Attend an Art Education Field Experience meeting the semester prior to taking ARU 475.
- ❑ Complete course prerequisites for field experience.
- ❑ Be taking or have taken all ARU, EDU, & SPU methods classes
- ❑ Obtain a grade of “B” or better in all courses.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CLINICAL EXPERIENCE & PRACTICUM (ARU 490/491):

- ❑ Complete ARU 475 with a satisfactory recommendation from their KU Field coordinator.
- ❑ Attend registration meeting and fill out an application (**Office of Clinical Experience & Outreach**) two semesters prior to taking ARU 490/491.
- ❑ Renew and maintain clear TB test results & criminal background reports (see above).

NOTE: Certification Candidates convicted of any offense may be removed from their field experience/clinical experience assignment (ARU 475, 490 & 491). Certification Candidates have the right to appeal decisions to the Dean of the College of Education who chairs the Council for Teacher Education.
