ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- ❑ Have an Emergency Teaching Permit or Intern Certificate in the certification area being sought.
- ❑ Be currently employed in a one year/full-time teaching position as the teacher of record in the certification area being sought. The employment must be within 35 miles of Kutztown University.
- ❑ Pass the Praxis tests #5134 ART CONTENT KNOWLEDGE and #5511 FUNDAMENTAL SUBJECTS as a condition of admittance into the Intern Program.

CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS:

- ❑ A clear TB test result and criminal background reports as required by Act 34 Criminal History Report, Act 114 FBI Federal Criminal History, Act 151 Child Abuse History, Act 24 Arrest/Conviction Report, and Act 126 Mandated Reporter Training.
- ❑ All clearances need to be on file prior to your starting the program. Clearances take approximately 4 – 6 weeks to process.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION:

- ❑ 3.0 cumulative GPA in a BA or a BFA degree in the Visual Arts or related field.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ARU 475 ART EDUCATION FIELD EXPERIENCE:

- ❑ Complete course prerequisites for the Intern Program, if applicable.
- ❑ Take ARU 475 Field Experience the first semester in the program.
- ❑ Be continually enrolled in the Intern Program, taking ARU, EDU, & SPU methods classes concurrently.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ARU 476 and 477 ART EDUCATION INTERNSHIP I and II:

- ❑ Obtain a grade of “B” or better in all courses.
- ❑ Complete ARU 475 with a satisfactory recommendation from the KU Field coordinator.
- ❑ Enroll in ARU 476 Internship I the second semester and upon successful completion, enroll in ARU 477 Internship II in the third semester of the program.
- ❑ Renew and maintain clear TB test results & criminal background reports (see above) as per your school district.

NOTE: Certification Candidates convicted of offenses that would prevent them from working as teachers may be removed from the Intern Program as described in the College of Education Clearance Policy. Certification Candidates have the right to appeal decisions to the Dean of the College of Education who chairs the Council for Teacher and Counselor Education.
