- All M.Ed. Initial Certification in Music Education students will be required to demonstrate current piano proficiency at the requisite level prior to requesting a clinical placement.
- Upon intake proficiency in techniques courses will be determined via interview and exam. Deficiencies will require enrollment in the appropriate on-campus courses; MUU 231: String Techniques, MUU 232: Woodwind Techniques, MUU 233: Brass Techniques, MUU 234: Percussion Techniques or their corresponding graduate level course.
- Students must meet all requirements for teacher candidacy including completing all required observation and exploration hours prior to receiving a clinical placement.
