The Professional Writing minor emphasizes effective writing and design, critical reading and analysis, and professionalization in the workplace. Students minoring in Professional Writing may choose from an array of classes in creative writing, technical writing, arts and entertainment writing, or journalism. The minor helps prepare students for graduate work or careers in professions such as author, editor, social media analyst, reporter, technical content writer, or web developer.
