## Minor in English as a Second Language (ESL) Requirements

The Minor in English as a Second Language (ESL) was developed for students who are interested in teaching English as a Second Language. The Pennsylvania Department of Education lists ESL as the number one teacher shortage area in PA. Candidates who successfully complete this program are also eligible to receive the K-12 ESL Education Endorsement Certification from the Pennsylvania Department of Education, after receiving their Level I Instructional Certificate.

Candidates who successfully complete this minor will be able to:

- apply knowledge of linguistics and the process of language acquisition to the planning, implementation, and management of ESL and content-area instruction.
- · understand culture as it affects student learning.
- develop and use classroom-based and language proficiency assessment.
- cultivate professional relationships with colleagues, students, and families.

Note that all students much achieve 18 credit hours of coursework. Further, a grade of "C" or better must be achieved in required core courses.


