

Environmental Geography Minor Requirements

The Environmental Geography Minor enriches an education in the environmental and social sciences by providing geographical perspectives on global issues. The minor also expands employment opportunities as its perspectives are valued by governmental agencies, non-governmental organizations, environmental conservation groups, business and marketing firms, para-legal professions, and education.

Note that all students must achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. Program requirement: 18 credits. The final GPA requirement for the Environmental Geography Minor is 2.0. Geography majors are not eligible for this minor.
