

Geology Minor Requirements

Students who pursue the Geology minor develop a deeper understanding of the Earth on a scientific level. The Geology minor provides two courses that establish the fundamentals of all geology, then gives students the freedom to choose three additional, more advanced courses in aspects of geology most interesting to them. The Geology minor does not provide the complete coverage required for licensure as a professional geologist, but does give students a very sound understanding that will feed their curiosity and supplement their career goals.
