

KU Planning Geography Minor Requirements

The Planning Geography Minor enriches an education in the environmental and social sciences by providing a geographical perspective on issues central to contemporary planning. The minor expands employment opportunities as its perspectives and techniques are valued by governmental agencies, non-governmental organizations, environmental conservation groups, planning organizations, business firms, and education.

Note that all students must achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. Program requirements: 18 credits. The final GPA requirement for the Environmental Geography Minor is 2.0. Geography majors are not eligible for this minor.
