

# German Communication and Cultures Minor Requirements

The German Communication and Culture Minor focuses on the language and cultures of the German-speaking world. The program prepares students to apply German language and intercultural skills to effectively interact in diverse personal, professional, and community settings.

*Program requirements: 18 credits. The final GPA requirement for the German Communication and Cultures minor is 2.0.*

GERM 211 German Composition and Conversation I (3 credits)

GERM 212 German Composition and Conversation II (3 credits)

## **German Communication and Cultures Elective Courses – 6 credits**

*Students may choose any two 3-credit GERM courses in consultation with an academic minor advisor. GERM 101 and 102 are not to be considered part of the minor and must be excluded from the 18-credit hour requirement in German.*
