The Minor in Literature includes required coursework in major English literary traditions, especially American and British, and in world literatures, classical and contemporary. Students additionally choose three English electives, all at the upper level. The minor emphasizes skills in literary and cultural analysis, in effective writing and rhetorical choices, and in understanding relations between literary traditions and social change.
