

KU Forensics Studies Minor Requirements

The minor in forensic studies is an 18-credit interdisciplinary collaboration which includes criminal justice, anthropology, biology, chemistry, psychology, and computer science. The minor requires successful completion of CRJU 301 Investigation and Intelligence, which reinforces an understanding of the criminal justice system.

In order to receive transcript recognition of a minor program, students must complete half of the minor course work at KU and must earn a minimum G.P.A. of 2.00 in their minor course work. No student may use more than two courses from their major or another minor toward the Forensic Studies minor. Please note that prerequisites are required for courses marked with an asterisk ().*
