



Master of Education Pre-K – 4 with Certification Requirements

The Master of Education Pre-K-4 with Certification program provides course preparation in education and includes clinical experience. The program leads to a master's degree and a teaching certification in Elementary Education Pre-K – 4. Courses will be taught in the following modalities: online, in-person, or blended format.

Note that all students must achieve 33 graduate credits and a minimum 3.0 overall GPA to graduate. The final GPA requirement for Pre-K – 4 with Certification is 3.0.
