Elective courses must include three credits of any additional 400 or 500-level MUU course plus three credits of any additional 400 or 500-level MUP, MUS or MUU course(s). The remaining nine elective credits may be chosen from any 400 or 500-level course(s) offered by the university. Elective credits can be used to develop other areas of emphasis within music or related educational concentrations outside of music. Suggested areas and courses are attached.

The M.Ed. in Music Education is not a teacher-certification program, however students who do not hold certification to teach music may opt to pursue this certification in conjunction with their requirements for the M.Ed. in Music Education. However, certification students should enroll first in the Post-Baccalaureate Music Education Certification program then apply to the M.Ed. in Music Education program after completing certification requirements.

A maximum of nine (9) transfer credits may be included toward the fulfillment of the requirements for the degree. Students must follow guidelines as written in the Graduate Bulletin.

Candidacy: Students are required to apply for candidacy between 12<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> credits. Candidacy forms are available online or in the KU Office of Graduate Studies.
