Music Minor Program Requirements

Students majoring in most programs at Kutztown University may elect a minor in music. A minor in music may be especially valuable to those who seek degrees in fields that are related to or make use of music. Some of these fields include business, communication studies, library science, psychology, anthropology, art, and languages.

Student Learning Objectives:

- 1. Perform with competence as soloist and ensemble members.
- 2. Identify, define, and engage the elements of music in sound and notation.
- 3. Describe current practices and historical trends in music.

Note that all students much achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. Program requirements: 18 credits.

Academic minors MUST reflect a minimum of 6 credits of advanced standing coursework in the major. Advanced standing coursework are courses 141 or higher.
