

Music History Minor Program Requirements

The Music History Minor allows students who may not have a music background to take a series of music literature and music history courses that will broaden their perspective of music in a variety of settings. Core courses provide a background in European classical music, music in non-Western cultures, and popular music styles in the United States. Elective courses provide opportunities to explore specific areas, such as jazz, film music, musical theater, women in music, and more.

Note that all students must achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. Program requirements: 18 credits.

Minors MUST reflect a minimum of 6 credits of advanced standing coursework in the minor. Advanced standing coursework are courses 141 or higher.
