# Public Relations Minor Requirements

The Minor in Public Relations provides opportunities for students to bolster their critical thinking and communication skills. Required coursework emphasizes foundational skills related to reputation management and organizational communication, and elective options provide the chance to build skills and portfolio pieces in social media, crisis communication, or visual communication.

Program Requirements: 18 credits. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 before declaring the minor in public relations. The final GPA requirement for public relations minor courses is 2.75. The public relations minor is not available to public relations major students.
