Pennsylvania German Studies Minor Requirements

Kutztown University's Minor in Pennsylvania German Studies offers opportunities to pursue intellectual and hands-on experiences in Pennsylvania German history, culture, language, crafts, and preservation. Students are encouraged to pursue their own interests within the structure of the program, through a variety of different disciplines, including anthropology, arts, geography, language, history, biology, library science, and many others. The program encourages use of the unique resources of the Pennsylvania German Cultural Heritage Center at Kutztown University. Students will have opportunities to receive professional experience in heritage programming, archiving, museum studies, community event planning, among many other skills.

Program requirements: 18 credits. The final GPA requirement for the Pennsylvania German Studies minor is 2.0.
