

Philosophy Minor Program

The Philosophy minor focuses on the development of skills in thinking and communicating clearly, critically, and creatively. The program coursework emphasizes student abilities to analyze and advance arguments dealing with logical and ethical issues. The Philosophy minor prepares students for graduate studies and nearly any area of work, including law, business, public service, publishing, medicine, ministry, and teaching.

Program requirements: 18 credits. The final GPA requirement for Philosophy Minor is 2.0.
