KU Political Science Minor Requirements

The minor in Political Science emphasizes analytical and writing skills together with developing knowledge of the US government, global political systems, and the means of inquiry in the social sciences. Students opting for the Political Science minor complete 18 credits of coursework, including the core course in American politics and either the core course in international relations or state & local government.

Program requirements: 18 credits. The final GPA requirement for Political Science Minor is 2.0. At least two elective courses need to be at the 141 level or above.
