Minor in Secondary Education Requirements

The Minor in Secondary Education was developed for students who are interested in the education of grades 7-12, but who are not seeking a teaching certificate. This 18-credit program has an emphasis on social justice, which applies to many other areas of study and will give students an insight into the challenges that underserved schools face.

Note that all students much achieve 18 credit hours of coursework. The final GPA requirement for the Minor in Secondary Education is 3.0. Additionally, this program is for non-Secondary Education majors and does not lead to a teaching certificate. Further, a grade of "C" or better must be achieved in required core courses.
