

Social Work Minor Requirements

The minor in Social Work provides the opportunity for an introduction to the science of helping; an understanding of the social welfare policies designed to help our most vulnerable populations; an understanding of the ethics and values of the social work profession; personal growth and development; practical hands-on assignments. The minor is designed to assist students majoring in Communication Studies, Criminal Justice, Education, Professional Studies, Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology and/or those who are embarking on a career as a helping professional.

Program requirements: 18 credits. The final GPA requirement for Social Work Minor is 2.0.
