The Spanish Communication and Cultures Minor focuses on the language and cultures of Spanish-speaking communities. The program prepares students to apply Spanish language and intercultural skills to effectively interact in diverse personal, professional, and community settings.

Program requirements: 21 credits. The final GPA requirement for the Spanish Communication and Cultures minor is 2.0.

Required Spanish Communication and Cultures Core Courses - 3 credits

SPAN 213 is the required course for students who are learning Spanish as a second language. SPAN 214 is the required course for native or Heritage learners of Spanish who have conversational Spanish skills but may or may not have formal education in Spanish. Students may not take both SPAN 213 and SPAN 214.

SPAN 213 Advanced Conversation in Spanish *or* SPAN 214 Written and Oral Communication for Spanish-speaking Heritage Learners (3 credits)

Spanish Communication and Cultures Elective Courses – 18 credits *Students may choose any six 3-credit SPAN courses.*
