

KU Art Minor Requirements

The Art minor allows students to explore a sampling of art approaches and media, from traditional to digital. Students take 6-12 credits in foundation 0-100 level courses and 6-12 credits in upper level 200-300 level courses for a combination of 18 credits for the minor. Upper-level courses exist in ceramics, drawing, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, and textiles.

Student Learning Objectives:

1. Demonstrate competency with the elements and principles of visual art.
2. Demonstrate technical proficiency in the production of art.
3. Create a professional presentation of artwork.

Note that all students must achieve 120 undergraduate credits and a minimum 2.0 overall GPA to graduate. Art minor program requirements: 18 credits. The final GPA requirement for Art Minor is 2.0.
