

This track is specifically designed for candidates presently teaching art in PA schools who seek PA Level I Certification in the visual arts. Candidates applying to the Art Education Intern Program are employed as the art teacher of record at schools within a 35-mile radius of Kutztown University, and work under emergency teaching permits.

Note that all students much achieve 27 credits to complete the certification intern program Note 30 total credits are needed to complete PreK-12 initial Art Certification and M.Ed. in Art Education
