Instructional Coaching Endorsement Requirements

The Instructional Coaching Endorsement program is for educators with an active PA Instructional I or II certificate (or out-of-state equivalent) and three years of effective teaching experience. This program leads to an Instructional Coaching endorsement.

Note that all students must achieve 12 graduate credits and a minimum 3.0 overall GPA to graduate. The final GPA requirement for Instructional Coaching Endorsement Program is 3.0.

ELED 531 Adult Learning Theory and Foundations in Instructional Coaching (3 credits) ELED 532 Practicum in Instructional Coaching (3 credits) *Note Practicum--80 hours of fieldwork are required by completion of the program. We have designed our courses so that candidates accrue the hours as they progress:15 hours will be completed in the leadership course,10 hours will be completed in the foundational coaching course, and 30 hours will be completed in the final practicum course.*
