Reading Specialist Certification Requirements

The Reading Specialist program provides course preparation in education. The program leads to a Reading Specialist certification. The program includes a passing score on the PDE Reading Specialist PK-12 exam.

Note that all students must achieve 27 graduate credits and a minimum 3.0 overall GPA to receive their certification. The final GPA requirement for Reading Specialist is 3.0.
